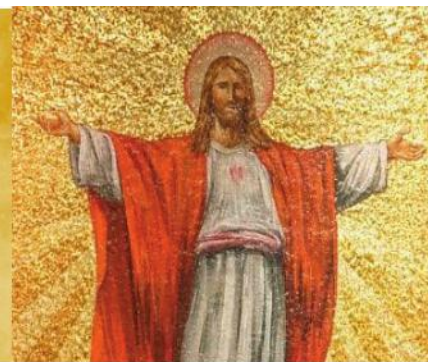

Take Up Your Cross

In a retreat talk given to priests, the late great Catholic bishop and TV host, Fulton Sheen, expressed his opinion on what he thought was the most serious phobia plaguing modern society: staurophobia. This is a Greek term meaning “fear of the cross.” The many crises afflicting the Church and the world, according to Bishop Sheen (speaking in the tumultuous 1960s), were the result of a fear-ridden flight from the cross of Jesus Christ, a reckless reluctance to look back to the salvific sacrifice on Calvary.

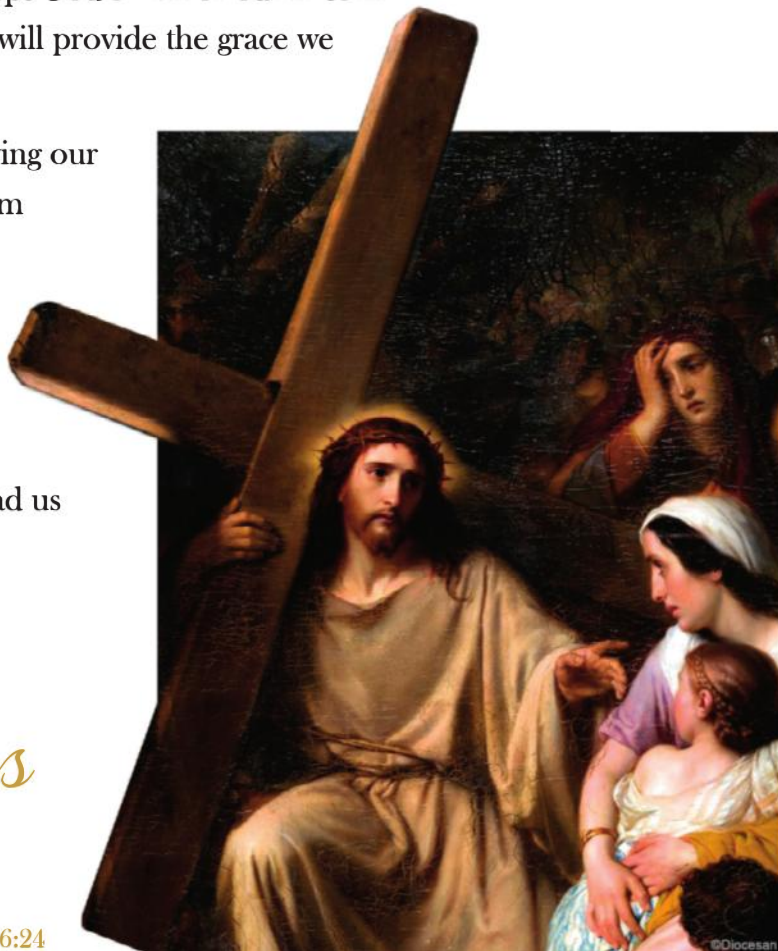
In today’s gospel, we see the hero from last week’s gospel, St. Peter, trying to shield Jesus from the shame and suffering of the cross. As a result, the Lord says to Peter, “get behind me, Satan!” What a stark contrast from last week’s interaction, in which Jesus calls Peter the Rock on which the Church would be built! The temptation to avoid the cross (suffering) is very human, and we all do it. Of course, suffering for its own sake is not virtuous. However, there are times when enduring a cross is unavoidable. It is in these situations that Christ invites us to accept God’s will for our lives in a strong yet serene manner, trusting that the Lord will provide the grace we need to persevere.

The alternative to denying ourselves and carrying our crosses is to numb ourselves with forms of escapism (diversions and distractions) and give up on those ordinary means of obtaining grace as Catholic Christians: prayer, good works, and the sacraments. For those who wish to follow Jesus, this is not an option. However, when we decide to take up our cross and follow him, the Lord will lead us to true freedom.

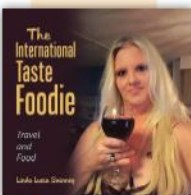
