

Retirement Fund for Religious



Confused about your obligations? The Church wants us to celebrate the 4th Sunday of Advent as a way to complete our preparation for the Lord's coming. Of course, we will want to celebrate Jesus' birth at either a Christmas Eve or Christmas Day Mass. This year, Christmas Eve falls on a Sunday. You'll honor the obligation to celebrate the 4th Sunday of Advent by attending either the 4:00 pm vigil on Dec. 23rd, or the 8 or 10am Mass on Sunday. You'll honor the celebration of Christmas by attending a Christmas Eve Mass (4pm, 6pm, 8pm (Spanish) or Midnight/Carols at 11:30am or a Christmas Day Mass (8 am or 10am).


