

- Embody the Parish Mission (Making and Strengthening Disciples of Christ) through service to the parish community.
- Follow the precepts of the Church and have a personal commitment to an active prayer/faith life.
- Are willing to contribute individual talents/skills to the best of his/her ability.

Requirements to be a candidate for the Jan. 2024 - Dec. 2025 term:

- Been a registered member of the parish at least 6 months
- Have received the Sacrament of Confirmation and are 18 years of age or older.
- Are willing to serve a 2 year term, and are available to attend Council meetings (held on Saturday mornings, four to five sessions per year, September through May)
- Participate in some aspects of Parish life


