

#### **Gospel Reflection**



DIOCESE OF ST. PETERSBURG Today's Gospel states that Jesus CATHOLIC "taught as one having authority, and MINISTRY not as the scribes" (Mark 1:22). appeal He proved his authority with accompanying signs, such as casting

out a demon. The people were astonished. Today, many of us waver between craving real authority and rebelling against authority altogether. We criticize our leaders for being too weak or the Catholic Church for being too firm. Why can't the Church loosen up her doctrines and "get with the times"? The truth is, the Church cannot "change with the times." Jesus, who "is the same today, yesterday, and forever," founded the Church (Hebrews 13:8). 
