

### About our new priest!

Fr. Augustine Adjen was the 8th of 9 children born into a devout and loving Catholic family in Breman, Ghana. Breman is a suburb of Kumasi, which is the second largest city in the country. Ghana is in West Africa, and it became the second nation in sub-Saharan Africa to gain its independence in 1957. It is a developing country, which is very peaceful and known for its hospitality.

Fr. Augustine studied for the priesthood at St. Gregory the Great Provincial Seminary in Kumasi, and he was ordained by Archbishop Gabriel Yaw Anokye on July 14th, 2018. He served as a Parochial Vicar for two years at Holy Rosary Parish and for four years at his current parish, St. John of the Cross.



Fr. Augustine enjoys school ministry, including serving as Head Teacher for the missionary school of St. John of the Cross International School, where he mentors, trains, and forms over eight hundred students for God, country, and the world. Fr. Augustine is looking forward to the opportunity to learn about American education and be involved with ministry and formation in our Sacred Heart and Morning Star Schools!

Last year, Fr. Augustine served in our diocese at Resurrection Parish in Riverview and Our Lady of Guadalupe Parish Mission in Wimauma for a couple of months. He looks forward to returning to the Diocese of St. Petersburg to serve our community here at Sacred Heart. He understands that the priesthood is a call to the service of God and humanity, which he strives to do wholeheartedly. His core values are diligence, respect, and humility. For his hobbies, Fr. Augustine loves to read, listen to music, sing, and play soccer. He would love to learn how to swim during his time with us!

We look forward to welcoming Fr. Augustine in July, when he officially begins his assignment with us. Please pray for Fr. Augustine as he prepares to make this major change in his life in order to serve our community!
