



Faith Formation

Registration for 2025-2026 is now open!

Grades K-5: For those not attending a Catholic School, these classes are held on Sunday mornings beginning with the 9:30am Mass. First class is **September 14th**. You can register online by scanning the QR code or contacting the parish office.

Will your child be in 1st grade this fall?

To receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion, children must attend Faith Formation classes during 1st and 2nd grade.

Confirmation in our parish normally occurs in 6th grade.

Following Diocesan guidelines, it is a two-year preparation program with Grade 5 (first- year of preparation) and Grade 6 the year of the sacrament. If your child was enrolled in our Grade 5 faith formation program last year we will be mailing a registration packet to your house.

Seminarian Spotlight

Kevin Buete

Kevin Buete is in his Propaedeutic year at St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary. He is a St. Petersburg native. He was baptized at Blessed Trinity, but he has spent most of his life (including education, pre-k thru 8th grade) at St. Paul's in St. Petersburg. He is the son of Doctors Eric and Maura Buete and the oldest brother of his four siblings: Lauren, Rebecca, Christine, and John Paul. He is an alumnus of St. Petersburg Catholic High School.



He was a performing arts instructor at SPCHS after his graduation from Belmont University in Nashville, TN. He played in the Folk Group at the 9:30 Mass at St. Paul's for about five years before he was asked to become the Music Minister for the LifeTeen Mass at St. Paul's. He was a music minister at youth, LifeTeen, and Young Adult events all over the diocese, as well as a substitute music minister at many other parishes. 
