

### Lay Pastoral Ministry Institute

Want to grow in your faith and serve the Church? The Lay Pastoral Ministry Institute may be just what you need. Since 1998, the LPMI has provided education and formation for laity in the Catholic faith. The program is designed to enhance personal faith and develop intellectual aptitude to enrich personal ministry. It is a four-year program: an informal year of discernment and three years of formal academic training and spiritual growth. Upon completion of the program, participants are formally "commissioned" by the Bishop.

The initial segment of the program, the Year of Discernment, consists of eight Saturday sessions from 9:30am to 3:00pm. The classes meet at Christ the King Parish, located at 821 S. Dale Mabry Hwy, Tampa and will begin **September 13**, continuing monthly through April 2026. 

# **Seminarian Spotlight**

## **Alexander Fleming**

Alexander Fleming was born and raised in Tampa and graduated from Robinson High School in south Tampa in 2019. He was baptized and confirmed at Christ the King Parish in 2020 after joining the RCIA program. He worked as a cook at a local Tijuana Flats for three years and left to go into seminary. He is now in his senior year of formation at St. Joseph Seminary College in Louisiana. He has always been close to his family; his dad, grandparents and



brother all have played a huge role in his journey to becoming Catholic and discerning the priesthood. Alexander first felt God's call to discernment when he was in the RCIA program to become Catholic. At first, he thought it was just an interest in what the priesthood was, but as time moved on, he could not stop thinking about the possibility of becoming a priest. Going to Mass and a daily prayer life were two major ways that he has been discerning the call.


