

Our Stewardship

Stewardship for August 30-31

Due to the Labor Day holiday, the stewardship numbers will not be available until next week.

Dear Parishioners,

I was informed this weekend that some of you had questions and concerns about the annual financial report and overview, particularly the high dollar amount allocated for the "Pastoral Leadership" and "Worship/Music" categories.

Pastoral Leadership \$182,227: I can assure you that Fr. Augustine and I are not receiving \$90,000/year salaries. If that were the case, I would be driving a nicer car and have a membership at Pasadena Yacht & Country Club! However, we are afforded the opportunities for an annual retreat and continuing education. We also have very good health insurance, which certainly helped us this year given Fr. Augustine's surgery, hospital stay, and rehab program. We also have a modest budget for table expenses (food) and we receive reimbursement for our car insurance. And the Diocese of St. Petersburg is one of only a few dioceses that still have pension funds for their priests. The cost to the parish for all of these expenses is determined by the Diocese. The budget here also includes the stipends for visiting priests when one of us is sick or away, and the two annual penance services.

Worship/Music \$125, 215: Again, the salaries of our music ministers are only a fraction of this number. This category includes the liturgical supplies we need for Mass and other liturgies, including the missalettes, hosts, wine, votive and altar candles, and flowers. This number is higher than usual because of the upgrades and repairs we did on our A/V system in the church, including a new sound board and a couple new speakers. I hope this settles any concern or speculation over these categories. As it said in the bulletin with the financial overview, any questions or concerns, please call Tony Mazzella in the parish office.




Vocation Spotlight




