

Mercy in Action at our Missionary Co-op Parish, St. Joseph Catholic Church

At St. Joseph Catholic Church in South St. Petersburg, two vibrant ministries—the Pantry Ministry and the Friday Hot Meal Ministry—serve as beacons of hope for our neighbors in need. Every Tuesday and Thursday, the Pantry provides groceries, beverages, and occasional clothing to 50–60 individuals. Every Friday evening, the Hot Meal Ministry—led by Bruce D. Harris, Ph.D.—serves 55–65 nutritious meals, many rescued by 360 Eats, to those facing hunger and isolation.

These ministries embody the Corporal Works of Mercy and rely heavily on prayers, volunteers, and donations from sister parishes like **Sacred Heart**. During this Jubilee Year of Hope, we invite you to help us expand this mission of love and dignity.

Your support helps nourish both bodies and souls.

Of course, our Lord always hears the prayers we offer for others, but some find special meaning in having a Mass offered for a specific intention. We have opened the 2026 Mass Book. Please be reasonable and limit the number of intentions you request at this time so that others will also be able to have their requests honored. If you are able, coming to the office is the most efficient way to reserve a Mass as it allows you to immediately see what dates are open.

Keep in mind...

- The suggested donation is \$10 per Mass, however, please understand that this is a voluntary offering and not a fee. We will be happy to offer a Mass without a gift being given.
- Some find special meaning in dedicating the sanctuary candle to a specific prayer intention. The candle that signifies Jesus' presence in the tabernacle burns for approximately 7 days and so you can have the candle burn for a deceased loved one or to honor an individual or anniversary for a chosen week. An offering of \$25 is typically given for this.




