

Mass Intentions for 2026

Of course, our Lord always hears the prayers we offer for others, but some find special meaning in having a Mass offered for a specific intention. We have opened the 2026 Mass Book. Please be reasonable and limit the number of intentions you request at this time so that others will also be able to have their requests honored. If you are able, coming to the office is the most efficient way to reserve a Mass as it allows you to immediately see what dates are open.

Keep in mind...

- The suggested donation is \$10 per Mass
- Some find special meaning in dedicating the sanctuary candle to a specific prayer intention. The candle that signifies Jesus' presence in the tabernacle burns for approximately 7 days and so you can have the candle burn for a deceased loved one or to honor an individual or anniversary for a chosen week. An offering of \$25 is typically given for this.

Abundance Holy Hour

In 2004, Pope Saint John Paul II blessed six monstrances to be used around the world for Eucharistic Adoration, inviting the faithful to pray for an increase in vocations.

One of these, known in the U.S. as the "Vocations Monstrance," was entrusted to Serra International to travel to parishes across North America. We were blessed to welcome this special monstrance in our diocese, uniting in prayer for vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life during the monthly Abundance Holy Hour.

The Abundance Holy Hour is hosted once a month by the Serra Club, at the St. Jude the Apostle Cathedral where we gather as a Diocese to pray for an abundance of vocations to the priesthood and religious life. The next Holy Hour will be on Wednesday, October 22, at 6:30 p.m.




