

St. Francis's reverence for God's creatures and marginalized people serves as a powerful model for the Church's mission to cherish and defend the dignity of every human being, highlighting the interconnectedness of life in God's creation.

All Souls Day Mass of Remembrance:





Vocation Spotlight

Michael Santos


