

St. Jude the Apostle Medal

Last Sunday, Bishop Parkes presided at a solemn Evening Prayer Service with the annual conferral of the St. Jude the Apostle Medals. These medals are given to an individual or married couple from each parish of the diocese to recognize those faithful stewards showing distinguished and outstanding service to their parish. The program for the ceremony states that this medal "acknowledges the great gift of the Church, its people, exemplified in these individuals who through their generosity and love of their faith have greatly contributed to spreading the Gospel of Jesus Christ in their parish community.".

For Sacred Heart, this year's St. Jude Medal recipient was Barbara Pellegrino. You may not know Barbara by name, but almost certainly by sight. Hers is the friendly face that greets each person entering our gift shop in the narthex. Barbara truly understands what it means to be a good steward, using the gifts God has given her–especially her faith, friendliness, and retail management skills-to build up the Body of Christ. Think of how many statues of Mary & The Saints, Crucifixes, Bibles, and other devotional items are displayed in peoples' homes because of her stewardship! A conservative estimate of hours Barbara has offered in service to the parish gift shop over the years is 7,000! About a dozen Sacred Heart parishioners attended the ceremony in support of Barbara, a great testimony to how loved and appreciated she is here!

Our Sacred Heart Catholic School middle school religion teacher, Sister Mary Ann Urch, also received the Medal for her parish, St. Joseph's, in south St. Pete. Congratulations Sister Mary Ann and Barbara, and thank you for your tremendous example of faithful stewardship!
