Vocation Spotlight

Vincent Washburn

Vincent Washburn is a seminarian from St. Michael the Archangel Parish in Hudson. Vincent grew up in Hudson where he graduated from Fivay High School in 2016. After graduation, he attended Pasco-Hernando State College for two years before transferring to USF Tampa where he earned a bachelor's in psychology in 2020. Despite his plans of becoming a forensic psychologist, the idea of priesthood entered his mind while a senior in high school and



remained with him throughout college. While still a student at USF, he began working as part-time Youth Minister at St. Michael's Parish in Hudson where he eventually began working full-time as Youth Minister, Director of Liturgy, and coordinator of the parish's ministry to the sick and homebound. After experiencing the depth of parish ministry with people of all ages and in various life circumstances, it became clear to him in prayer that a life of service to the Church as a priest, was indeed the Lord's invitation to him. Vincent entered seminary for the Diocese of St. Petersburg in 2021 and attended St. Joseph Seminary College in St. Benedict, Louisiana where he graduated in 2023. Later that year, he began his theological studies at St. Vincent de Paul Regional Seminary in Boynton Beach, Florida and is currently in his Pastoral Year at the Catholic Student Center at USF Tampa
