

Letter of Gratitude from Fr. Augustine's Bishop



Dear Beloved Parishioners of Sacred Heart Catholic Church,

Please receive cordial greetings from the Archbishop's Office, Kumasi, Ghana.

It is with a heart filled with joy, gratitude, and paternal affection that I write to express, on behalf of Clergy, Religious, and Faithful of the Archdiocese of Kumasi (Ghana), my deepest appreciation to you, the entire Parish Family of Sacred Heart Catholic Church, for your exceptional kindness and Christian charity towards Rev. Fr. Augustine Adjen Barimah, your Parochial Vicar and our beloved priest.

Fr. Barimah faced a most critical health crisis when we was diagnosed with **severe multivessel coronary artery disease**, a condition that left him with only one functional artery supplying blood to his heart. In that moment of danger and uncertainty, far from his homeland, you surrounded him with love, support, and prayer.

Your generosity - both spiritual and material - before, during, and after his surgery, reflects the very heart of the Gospel. As **St. Paul** reminds us, "Bear one another's burdens, and so fulfill the law of Christ." (Galatians 6:2). Truly, you have borne the burden of your brother priest with compassion and faith, and by doing so, you have fulfilled the command od live that lies at the centre of Christian discipleship.


