

The Baptism of Jesus and The Birthday of Ella Rose

This Sunday, one of Sacred Heart's newest family members, Ella Rose Reed, will celebrate her first birthday. I am so grateful for the warm welcome this community has given her, especially all the toys and treats she received as gifts for Christmas. Speaking of that Holiday, this Sunday's feast of the Baptism of the Lord officially concludes the Christmas season. This special event in the life of Christ is a kind of second Epiphany; that is to say, the divine nature of Jesus is revealed at his baptism in the Jordan River as it was revealed to the Magi through the guidance of a star. Though Jesus had no need of repentance from sin, he was baptized by his cousin John to sanctify the waters of baptism, and to serve as an example for us to follow.

Baptism is a great gift for us because through this sacrament, we are given a new birth into a life of Grace and adopted as sons and daughters of God, joint heirs with Christ to the kingdom of heaven. At your baptism, the Father said, "this is my beloved child, with whom I am well pleased." So, I encourage you to discover the date of your own baptism and begin to celebrate it as a second birthday, rejoicing in the many gifts Our Father in heaven has given to you through the graces of this wondrous sacrament.


