

Catholic Ministry Appeal

Jesus was the genuine article, the real deal. He practiced what he preached, and the Beatitudes delivered during his Sermon on the Mount were his guide for living. Jesus lived them, offering comfort, satisfying hunger, extending mercy, bringing peace. He also lived the persecution and insults. The spiritual qualities the Beatitudes enumerate are a road map of sorts. Live according to these blessings, and you are living a life that is pleasing to the Heavenly Father, one that will lead to him. Up until now, the Jews had the 10 Commandments to keep them on the path to God. Jesus is now giving them the eight Beatitudes.

It won't be easy. Jesus warns that others will "insult you and persecute you and utter every kind of evil against you [falsely] because of me." But this is cause for rejoicing, "for your reward will be great in heaven." This life is preparation for the next. Its suffering is transient; the joy we experience with God the Father is eternal. Its blessings will pale in comparison to the blessings of everlasting life.

Let us pray that we live this life in a way that will lead us to God in the next. May we offer blessings to the poor, hungry, mourning, and persecuted among us through support of the Catholic Ministry Appeal so that they may see God's face in their affliction.



Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18. Mass will be offered at:

- 6:15pm Mass (with distribution of ashes)



Fasting and Abstinence guidelines during Lent

Fasting: Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday during Lent. Fasting means eating one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal. Snacking between meals is not allowed.

Abstinence: Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.


