

This ministry exists to ensure that they, too, are cared for, supported, and strengthened so they can continue answering God's call with generosity and joy. Megan's expertise, professionalism, and compassion became evident to us here at Sacred Heart last summer when our beloved parochial vicar, Fr. Augustine, had to undergo emergency open heart surgery. Megan provided crucial support and advice to Fr. Augustine and to me as we navigated the many challenges of his hospital stay and recovery. I owe Megan a debt of gratitude for her accompaniment. I also thank each of you who donated to the Catholic Ministry Appeal, because without your generosity, Megan's position would not exist. Ash Wednesday

Lent begins on Ash Wednesday, February 18. Mass will be offered at:

- 8:15am (school Mass with distribution of ashes)
- 12:15pm (with distribution of ashes)
- No Adoration and Confessions this evening
- 6:15pm (with distribution of ashes)



Fasting and Abstinence guidelines during Lent

Fasting: Catholics between the ages of 18 and 59 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday during Lent. Fasting means eating one full meal and two smaller meals that don't add up to a full meal. Snacking between meals is not allowed.

Abstinence: Catholics aged 14 and older are required to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays during Lent.


