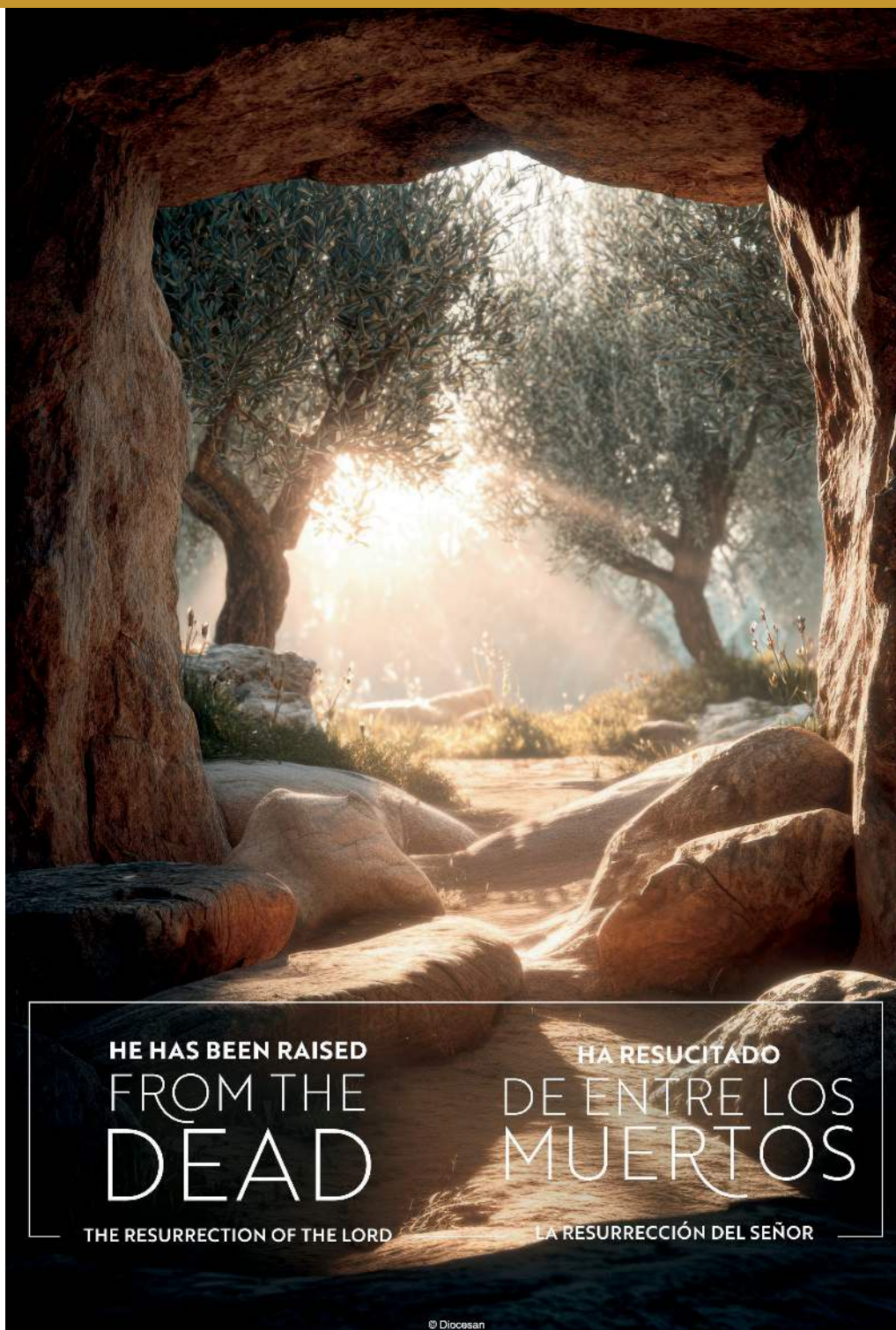

Alleluia, He is Risen! Indeed, He is Risen, alleluia!

Today, we celebrate the great day of the Resurrection, a day that should renew our hope and fill us with immense joy! Pope Saint John Paul II spoke well of the significance of the celebration of Easter, which was not merely a one-time historical event but a present spiritual reality which is constantly being renewed in us and through us.

"Yes, Christ is truly risen, and we are witnesses of this. We proclaim this witness to the world, so that the joy which is ours will reach countless other hearts, kindling in them the light of the hope which does not disappoint. If this mission may sometimes seem difficult, call to mind the words of the Risen Lord: 'I am with you always, to the close of the age' (Matthew 28:20). Certain of his presence, you shall fear no difficulty and no obstacle. His word will enlighten you; his Body and his Blood will nourish you and sustain you on your daily journey to eternity."

Next Sunday, on the Octave of Easter, the Church celebrates a special feast day, Divine Mercy Sunday. This is a day of extraordinary grace, officially decreed by Pope John Paul II in 2000, inspired by the revelations to St. Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun that received messages from the Lord Jesus in the 1930's. A special plenary indulgence for the total forgiveness and remission of sins can be received by the faithful in a state of grace (those without unconfessed mortal sins) who receive Holy Communion next Sunday. Jesus said to St. Faustina: "On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet."

Come, take advantage of these special graces by joining us for Mass next weekend, and also consider coming for the Divine Mercy Holy Hour at 2:30pm in the Chapel on Sunday, April 12th.

Junior Legion of Mary

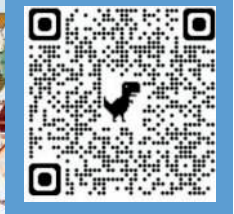

¡Aleluya, ha resucitado! ¡En verdad ha resucitado, aleluya!

Hoy celebramos el gran día de la Resurrección, un día que debe renovar nuestra esperanza y llenarnos de inmensa alegría. El Papa San Juan Pablo II expresó muy bien el significado de la celebración de la Pascua, la cual no es solo un acontecimiento histórico del pasado, sino una realidad espiritual presente que se renueva constantemente en nosotros y a través de nosotros.

“Sí, Cristo ha resucitado verdaderamente, y nosotros somos testigos de ello. Proclamamos este testimonio al mundo, para que la alegría que es nuestra llegue a innumerables corazones, encendiendo en ellos la luz de la esperanza que no defrauda. Si esta misión a veces puede parecer difícil, recuerden las palabras del Señor Resucitado: ‘Yo estoy con ustedes todos los días hasta el fin del mundo’ (Mateo 28:20). Seguros de su presencia, no temerán ninguna dificultad ni obstáculo. Su palabra los iluminará; su Cuerpo y su Sangre los alimentarán y los sostendrán en su caminar diario hacia la eternidad.”

El próximo domingo, dentro de la Octava de Pascua, la Iglesia celebra una fiesta muy especial: el Domingo de la Divina Misericordia.

Este es un día de gracia extraordinaria, oficialmente establecido por el Papa San Juan Pablo II en el año 2000, inspirado en las revelaciones a Santa Faustina Kowalska, una religiosa polaca que recibió mensajes de nuestro Señor Jesús en la década de 1930. Se puede recibir una indulgencia plenaria especial — para el perdón total y la remisión de los pecados— si los fieles están en estado de gracia (es decir, sin

pecados mortales sin confesar) y reciben la Sagrada Comunión el próximo domingo. Jesús le dijo a Santa Faustina: “En ese día están abiertas todas las compuertas divinas por las cuales fluyen las gracias. Que ninguna alma tema acercarse a Mí, aunque sus pecados sean como escarlata.”

Vengan y aprovechen estas gracias especiales uniéndose a nosotros en la Santa Misa el próximo fin de semana, y también consideren participar en la Hora Santa de la Divina Misericordia a las 2:30 p.m. en la Capilla, el domingo 12 de abril.
