Anointing of the Sick

The Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be offered **this weekend** immediately following each Mass. This healing sacrament is intended for baptized Catholics facing serious physical, mental, or emotional illness, preparing for major surgery, weakened by advanced age, or otherwise in grave spiritual need.

Who Should Receive the Sacrament?

- **Serious Illness:** Those diagnosed with a severe, chronic, or life-threatening condition.
- **Upcoming Surgery:** Individuals preparing for a major medical operation or procedure.
- **Advanced Age:** The elderly whose physical strength is significantly weakened, even without a specific acute illness.
- **Spiritual or Mental Burden:** Those suffering from deep psychological, emotional, or spiritual distress.

Guidelines for Participation

- **Not for Everyone:** Unlike Holy Communion, this is a specialized sacramental rite of healing and is reserved for those who fit the specific criteria listed on the left.
- **Location:** If you plan to receive the anointing, please move to the pews near the front/center aisle immediately after the final blessing.
- **State of Grace:** When possible, recipients should be lucid and have a basic desire for the sacrament. If they are conscious of grave (mortal) sin they should confess before receiving the anointing.

COR Men's Group

Cor, from the Latin word meaning heart, and the root word of courage, gives men the opportunity to build Christ-centered brotherhood through in-person gatherings centered on prayer, faith formation and fraternity. Through Cor, men strengthen their interior lives and sharpen each other to be holier sons, husbands, and fathers united in mission as disciples. Cor is for all men of the parish over 18. Cor is an initiative of the Knights of Columbus, however, membership in the Knights is not required. Cor gatherings are separate from council meetings.

Cor plans to meet each first Saturday of the month. The 8am morning Mass in the chapel followed by a Holy Hour of Eucharistic Adoration from 8:30-9:30 are optional. Fraternity and hospitality will begin at 9:30am in the Retreat House with coffee and refreshments.
